## **A Biographical Summary of Lowell K. Duckett**

Mr. Lowell Duckett served as a member of the Washington D.C. Metropolitan Police Department from September 1969 through March 1997 at which time he retired at the rank of Lieutenant. During his tenure he implemented the Tactical Action Plan/Delta Unit, an anti-gang unit targeting armed and violent gangs in the District of Columbia. Mr. Duckett commanded the Delta Unit from 1992 until 1995, during which time 16 gangs were completely shut down and approximately 2,000 guns were recovered. His 1996 report, "Tactical Action Program for MPD", resulted in a new tactical operational strategy being implemented

In recognition of his outstanding service, Mr. Duckett was awarded two Bronze Medals for merit, Two Silver Medals for valor, one Distinguished Public Service Award, three United States Attorney's Awards and fifteen Chief of Police Commendations for excellence. He has been cited as one of the most decorated officers in the Metropolitan Police Department. .

Mr. Duckett is currently employed by WACKENHUT SERVICES, INC., Savannah River Site and is serving as the President of the Security, Police and Fire Professionals of American Local #330 union. Mr. Duckett is a graduate of Claflin University with a BA in Sociology and Criminal Justice Administration and will soon graduate from Troy University with a Master of Science degree in Management.
